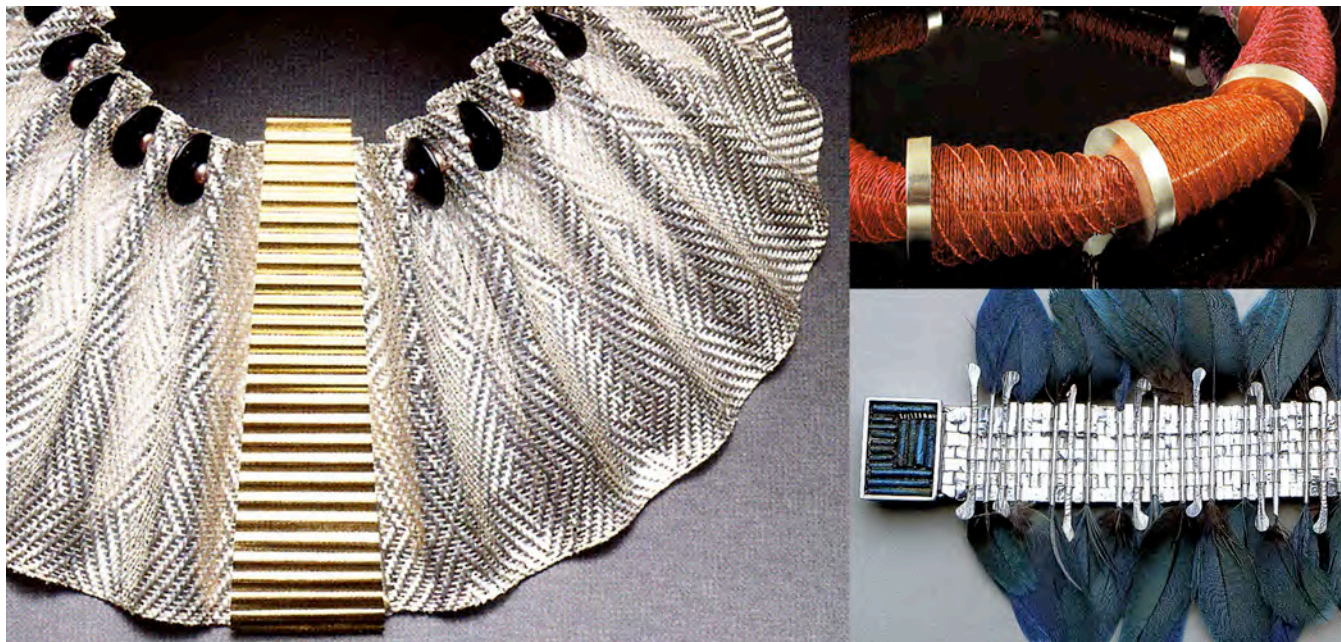


Textile Techniques in Metal
